

Seeking Traumatic Brain Injury Survivors for Brain Stimulation Memory Research

To be in this study, you must:

- be 19 years of age or older
- have had a traumatic brain injury at least 1 year ago
- be fluent in English and be able to read single words
- have no history of neurologic dysfunction, psychologic/psychiatric impairment, diagnosed attention deficit disorder, or learning disability
- not currently be in any kind of memory improvement program or therapy
- not be changing any psychoactive medications you take

Study participation will involve 3 visits of noninvasive brain stimulation with a device called transcranial Direct Current Stimulation (tDCS) and memorization tasks.

All 3 visits will be at Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital.

You will be compensated a \$25 grocery card per visit for your participation.
